ARTICLE 44 – FIRST-IN, FIRST OUT

Agreed upon Interpretation of Article 44, of CSXT Labor Agreement 1-023-07 as a result of discussions held in accordance with Article 32 of said agreement at Disputes Resolution Committee Meetings held in Sandestin, Florida on April 14, 2009.

The parties have agreed that reference to Pool Engineers was inadvertently omitted from this Article; as a result the following sentence will be added at the end of paragraph F:

“Pool Engineers will be marked up to the pool based on their off duty time.”

Additionally, the first sentence of Paragraph G will be amended as follows:

“Extra Engineers who are first out and available on ROAD, yard or combination extra boards shall be called in turn for service.” (The word road has been added).
